In 2017, Moringa Partnership made an equity investment in the company to expand its processing capacities and reach profitable US and European markets. thus, Tolaro aims to improve its product quality while ensuring a sufficient and timely supply of Raw Cashew Nuts (RCN) from the smallholder farmers around the processing facilities. The main objective of this capitalisation study is to evaluate the relevance and effectiveness of this subcontracting system with small producers.
