Project's goals and results

Main goals

The Fair Sahel project, coordinated by CIRAD, is implemented by a consortium of 13 research and development partners in three countries: Burkina-Faso, Mali and Senegal. It is financed to the tune of 7 million euros by the European Union, 1.5 million by AFD and financed by CIRAD and IRD for 0.5 million euros. It started in January 2020 for 4 years. The FAIR Sahel project is:

- A participatory approach to develop solutions that meet the constraints of producers
- A reflection on the agroecological levers that can be mobilized in the Sahel to optimize the efficiency and adaptation of agricultural production (sustainable soil management, functional plant biodiversity, optimization of agriculture-livestock interactions)
- A multi-level intervention to cover issues related to agroecology transition at the scale of the plot, communities and territories
- A project at the interface of research and development to promote the design and distribution of innovative systems

The objective of our intervention is to assess the level of progress of the activities since the start of the project, the adequacy of the intervention in relation to the theory of change, to identify the critical points and to propose readjustments for improve the achievement of objectives
