Project's goals and results

Main goals

Côte d'Ivoire has committed to restore **5 million hectares** of degraded land and forests by 2030. EFI, within the Forest4future (F4F) project, in partnership with GIZ and institutions Ivorian trustees, wishes to continue its support for state and non-state actors in their initiatives for **preservation, management and restoration** of the natural capital of Côte d'Ivoire, in particular by supporting field forestry operations (assisted natural regeneration, reforestation, agroforestry). The objective of the mission is to contribute to these overall objectives of F4F, in particular by facilitating the deployment of forest restoration activities.

Specific objectives

- SO1.** Spatial and forest characterization of the F4F Project intervention villages and in particular the evaluation of the forest potential of the project area (mapping and inventories)
- SO2.** Development of a land use planning methodology at the village level including participatory mapping in 2 villages
