Project's goals and results

Main goals

This study was commissioned within the framework of the PSAC (Agricultural Sector Support in Ivory Coast Project) and is part of PSAC's 3rd component: "Modernization of the cotton sector and promotion of cashew processing". This component supports the cotton sector's revival program, and the improvement of the processed share
