As part of its due diligence process, a Belgian investor conducted an initial environmental and social assessment focused on the industrial sites of a cashew nut exporter based in Côte d'Ivoire with whom a partnership is being considered. In order to obtain certain guarantees prior to the investment, Nitidæ was asked by the investor to conduct an assessment of the exporter's supply chain, particularly with regard to Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) risks, traceability and sustainability practices.
