Project's goals and results

Main goals

The market study on biochar at the international and national scope, requested by ENABEL in Côte d'ivoire, is part of the <u>implementation of the VABICUI project</u>, which aims at strengthening organic waste valorization and clean cooking sectors. The action contributes to the reduction efforts of greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions in the country.

There are diverse possibilities to recycle and valorize by-products and waste from agricultural, industrial and even urban sectors. Among these, biochar appears as one appropriate solution, today raising greater interest mainly due to the apparent consolidation of climate finance.
